LOOKS GREAT & DRIVES Even Better

Meet Bob, a breath-taking 1965 Rolls-Royce Silver Cloud III with extensive road experience. Considering his good looks and fantastic drivabilty, it should come as no surprise that Bob is a show car through-and-through.

The livery on LSKP5, painted Mason's Black back when it was first restored, is lustrous and spectacularly shiny with only minor imperfections. The car's striking mirror finish is further elevated with tan coach stripes, chrome accents, pinstriped wheel covers, and clear parking lights, a rarity given the lenses were a U.S.-only delivery option.

On the inside, Bob exhibits the same elegant, inviting interior for which Silver Clouds are known. Drivers and passengers alike will enjoy the soft beige leather, Wilton wool carpet with mouton sheepskin overlays, and gorgeous burled walnut veneer that makes the dashboard a sight all on its own. There are even a couple surprises, including a miniature fire extinguisher next to the driver's side kick panel and an upgrade to the stereo system that brings Bob into the 21st century, thus modernizing the classic car-driving experience. (Future owners of LSKP5 will love the addition of Sirius XM, as well as the fact that Bob is now Bluetooth-compatible and phone/tablet-friendly.)





A REAL GO-GETTER

At the time of its restoration, LSKP5 had accumulated a mere 38,000 miles on it. In the past seven years, under the ownership of R. Lee Herman, MD, Bob has traveled an additional 35,000 miles. That's an average of 5,000 miles per year since 2013 — an impressive feat that's indicative of the car's comfort and reliability.

The 1965 Rolls-Royce Silver Cloud III, VIN No. LSKP5 and later known as "Bob," is delivered to its first owner, Benjamin F. Lucas, Jr., of Baltimore, Maryland. Lucas purchased the car from Sausman Chevrolet in Lemoyne, Pennsylvania, after it was ordered new from the New York dealership Rolls-Royce, Inc.


LSKP5 moves to California, where it is thoroughly restored. While there, the Rolls-Royce is acquired by John Ellison of the Calumet Collection in La Jolla. Ellison recruits Pedro Meyer, also of the Calumet Collection, to further enhance the car's restoration.

LSKP5 is then sold to its current owner, R. Lee Harman, MD, who will thoroughly enjoy and care for Bob in the years to come.

2020

The Silver Cloud III is listed for auction. In the seven years it was owned by Harman, LSKP5 traveled 35,000 miles and won multiple awards competing in concours events across the country.












