

Built back in December of 1967, we think this 1968 Shelby
Mustang GT350 looks and feels better than it did when it first
hit the market. In fact, given its historical accuracy and superb
attention-to-detail, it may even be one of the finest examples of

This GT350's impressive condition can be attributed, in large part, to its complete restoration back in 2008. Restorers went to painstaking lengths to conform to the Shelby's original specifications, as evidenced by the car's Highland Green exterior and dark interior, complete with black carpet and factory option bucket seats. Other original features include the sport deck rear seat, tilt-away steering column and steering wheel, tachometer and trip odometer, A/C with metal Ford tag on the compressor, heavy-duty battery and, though included in the auction but not currently installed on the car, the intake manifold and carburetor.

If you're looking for a sporty, award-winning ride that stays true to its roots, look no further. This awe-inspiring Shelby Mustang may just be the one for you.
