## DROPHEAD COUPE TO DESIGN No. 700 FOR BENTLEY CONTINENTAL CHASSIS

CONSTRUCTION	Framework of special Park Ward Patent lightweight construction covered with aluminium panels. Wide vision screen pillars and the scuttle reinforced. Chromium plated superimposed moulding on lower edge of body and front wings.
SEATING	Two persons in the front on sliding bucket type seats, the backs of which are adjustable for rake and tip forward to give access to the rear seat which accommodates two persons and incorporates a centre folding armrest. Combined glove box and hinged armrest fitted between front seats and adjustable armrest to each door, recessed to serve as door pull.
	The rear seat cushion hinges upwards and the seat valance folds over and extends to provide for additional luggage carrying capacity.
DOORS	Two, hung on front pillars, fitted with best quality locks, striking plates and con- cealed hinges, etc.
	Push button release type exterior door handles. Private lock fitted to both doors and interior safety catches incorporated in remote control interior handles.
	Open pocket recess in each door.
WINDOWS	Glasses to doors to drop flush and operated by mechanical lifts with winder handles. Swivelling ventilating windows with drip channels fitted to front of doors. Safety glass throughout.
HEAD	Park Ward type manually operated head fitting, covered with suitable available material to standard range of shades. Supplementary inner lining of cloth to tone with upholstery. Large rear curtain made to open and fold down by zip fastener when desired. Envelope cover of leather to match upholstery provided for hood when down and with bag for stowing when not in use.
WINDSCREEN	Made in one panel, curved and permanently fixed, glazed with laminated safety glass. Dual wipers fitted at base of screen.
DIRECTION INDICATORS	Approved flashing type, wired to a time switch fitted on the instrument board capping.
VENTILATION	Fresh air inlet to interior through frontal grilles.
WINGS	Special Park Ward type wings of aluminium integral with body, with stone shields and mud lips. Access to petrol filler by means of hinged door in offside rear wing, locked internally.
INSTRUMENT BOARD	All instruments supplied with chassis fitted up thereon in approved manner. Cubby hole on passenger's side having a hinged door and fitted with lock. Cigar lighter fitted.

	Pull-out picnic table under centre of board incorporating ashtray.
TRIMMING STYLE	Of approved design.
INTERIOR FITTINGS	One electric light at rear operated automatically with opening and closing of the doors. Switch provided also for independent operation.
	Ashtrays in convenient position for rear seat passengers.
	Interior driving mirror.
	Sun visors attached to screen rail with vanity mirror on passenger's visor.
	Slip pocket provided at each side of scuttle.
FLOOR COVERING	Floor to be covered with pile carpet, colour to tone with upholstery, suitably underlined.
	Heel pads fitted to front carpet.
LUGGAGE AND TOOLS	Luggage boot at rear, access being gained by means of door hinged at the top and operated by push button release type handle incorporating lock.
	Road tools and small tools conveniently accommodated in rear boot.
	Light in rear boot operated automatically by opening and closing of boot lid.
SPARE WHEEL	One spare wheel and tyre supplied with chassis accommodated in the rear boot on the offside and fitted with carpet cover.
OTHER	Combined stop-tail lamp, flasher lamp and reflector built into each rear wing.
EQUIPMENT	Bumpers fitted to front and rear.
	Heating, demisting and defrosting equipment as provided with chassis.
	Radio set as provided with chassis with controls recessed from behind instrument board.
	Windscreen spray equipment on scuttle controlled by switch on instrument board.
	Concealed and internally operated locks to bonnet.
	Connecting up lamp equipment supplied with chassis.
	Provision at front and rear for identification plates.
EXTERIOR FINISH	Colour to standard range of shades and distrubution to choice.
UPHOLSTERY	In best quality Vaumol leather to standard range of shades.
INTERIOR WOODWORK	Polished wood fillets, finishers, etc., of walnut. Dadoes and instrument board veneered on face.
NOTE :	For cars intended for use abroad, appropriate modifications would be made to such items as number plates, private door locks, etc., etc., to equip the car for the country concerned.

Bentley Continental.

We are now in a position to release details of the new Bentley Continental model, which will be offered with Special Lightweight All-Metal coachwork product by Messrs. Park Ward and H.J.Mulliner. The specification of the chassis in the main closely follows the 'S' Series model, but acdifications have been incorporated in order to maintain that same degree of high performance associated with the Bentley Continental.

The Engine, with a Six-Port Cylinder Head, gives increased power, but the most noticeable difference is the suspension and general handling of the car, which is vastly superior to the previous model, with the result that higher average speeds can be maintained with added safety, due to the capacity of the brakes having been increased by 15%.

The air-conditioning and demisting system introduced on the 'S' Series cars is incorporated in the Continental, and additional engineering improvements have been introduced which will be immediately noticeable when driving the car. As an example, the control to the rear shock-dampers is very quickacting, and it is possible to flick the switch to 'hard' when crossing a hump-backed bridge at speed, and the damper will act in time to prevent bounce.

Alternative designs of coachwork are available, and details, together with prices, are given hereunder:-
